

Can panels of different wattages be connected in parallel



Overview

As we said above, when connecting solar panels in series, we get an increased wattage in combination with a higher voltage. Such 'higher voltage' means that series connection is more often applied in grid-tied solar systems where: 1) the system voltage is often at least 24 volts, and 2) the solar array output voltage. Here is a series connection of solar panels of different voltage ratings and the same current rating: You can see that if one of the solar panels has a lower voltage rating (and the same current rating) compared to the remaining panels, the output power is lower than in the previous. The next basic type of connecting solar panels is in parallel. Connecting solar panels in parallel is just the opposite of series connection and is used to increase the total output current of. A combination of series and parallel connection is also possible. Indeed, this depends on the maximum possible total output voltage and maximum possible total output current of the solar. Here is a parallel connection of solar panels of different voltage ratings and the same current rating: As you can see, things are getting worse, since the total voltage of the array is.

Connect the different strings in parallel. If 3 or more strings, you need to fuse each string before your parallel junction. And fuse/wire for max possible amps at any one time.

Different wattage/voltage panels connecting to an mppt controller

For panel strings connected in series, I_{mp} of different panels must match to within 10% of high to low (i.e., 10 amp I_{mp} panels mixed with 9 amp I_{mp} panels in series). For panels (and panel strings) connected in parallel, V_{mp} must match within 10% of hi to low (i.e., V_{mp} 30 volts and V_{mp} 33 volts in parallel is OK).

Mixing Solar Panels: Can I Mix and Match Solar Panels?

Different panels/wattages in same array?

You can also, add one 11 amp panel in series with a smaller pair of parallel connected 5.5 amp panels (which add up to ~11 amps). Because solar panels are current sources and not voltage sources, they "share loads" pretty nicely (each contributes its available current as long as V_{panel} is somewhere between 0 volts and V_{mp}).
