The project is being funded by a \$10 million concessional loan and a \$5 million grant from the Asian Development Bank (ADB), while the Saudi Fund for Development and state-owned Solomon Power are providing \$10 million each. In October 2023, ADB introduced more favorable concessional lending terms for small island developing states, including Solomon Islands, to meet infrastructure needs, strengthen social services, scale up climate action and disaster risk reduction, and assist in minimizing future debt-servicing.
