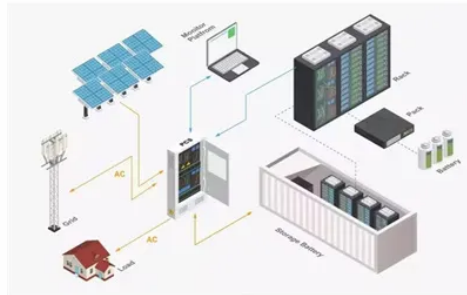


Households using solar power



Overview

As of early 2025, nearly 5 million households (specifically, 4.7 million) have solar panels installed on their rooftops, according to a SolarReviews report.
