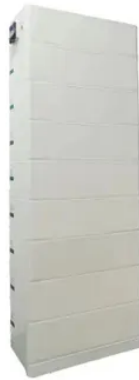


# How many energy storage projects are there in Morocco



## Overview

As of May 2025, more than 45% of Morocco's power installed capacity was attributed to renewable energy compared to 37% in 2021. The mix comprises 44% of wind energy, 24% hydropower, 17% solar energy, and 15% pumped storage plants. According to the National Electricity Regulatory Authority (ANRE), Morocco's electricity production in 2023 came from coal (64 percent), hydroelectricity (0.8 percent), natural gas (10 percent), wind (15). This article explores how the country's strategic investments in battery storage, pumped hydro, and hybrid systems are reshaping its energy landscape while. Morocco has increased its energy storage capacity by 30% since 2021, reaching 3.2 million cubic meters in 2025, Energy Transition and Sustainable Development Minister Leila Benali said Monday during a parliamentary question session.
