

Ireland sells energy storage power



Overview

New wholesale electricity market rules have been introduced in Ireland, designed to allow battery storage assets to participate directly. From 11 November, the Scheduling and Dispatch Programme (SDP) was launched. Since 2020, Ireland has made impressive strides by connecting over one gigawatt (GW) of energy storage capacity to its electricity grid – a significant milestone on its path to generating 80% electricity from renewable sources such as wind and solar energy by 2030 and eventually achieving the net. This study by TNEI highlights how energy storage can support the operation of the grid and reduce dispatch down of renewable generation.
