

Principle of concentrated solar cells



Overview

Modern CPV systems operate most efficiently in highly concentrated sunlight (i.e. concentration levels equivalent to hundreds of suns), as long as the solar cell is kept cool through the use of heat sinks. Diffuse light, which occurs in cloudy and overcast conditions, cannot be highly concentrated using conventional optical components only (i.e. macroscopic lenses and mirrors). Concentrator photovoltaics (CPV) (also known as concentrating photovoltaics or concentration photovoltaics) is a technology that generates electricity from sunlight.
