heat issue on the connector

So I just noticed the connector on my solar cable is heating up to 120F when I am pulling 2.2KW from the solar array. The solar array is $445 \times 6 = 2670W$, flat-mounted, so I don't expect it can pull more than this power. The solar cable has a rating of 30A, at 85V, that is, 2550W. The cable is cold, but the connector gets warm.
